(4) P entecost	(w/leaven) Spiritual blessing (sin offering)	Acts 2:1
(5) T rumpets	Recalling Israel	Matt. 24:31
(6) A tonement	Affliction due to sin (Israel recognizing their mistake)	Zech. 12:9 & 10
(7) T abernacles	Rest in God's presence. Remembering (Deut. 11:12)	Zech. 14:11–19
